- Intern must possess an overall love and respect for animals
- Already have the fundamental skills of grooming, tacking, haltering, and leading horses
- Must have successfully been a counselor in the SCS summer camp program for two summers, showing great responsibility, reliability, and customer service. During this time, the internship applicant must have shown the ability to work productively in the heat for multiple days/weeks in a row, ability and willingness to help campers, tack horses, keep the facility clean, and maintain a positive attitude

SCS realizes that we require our employees and interns to work a lot of hours doing intensive manual labor. We appreciate our employees and interns and strive to provide as much flexibility in their work schedule as possible, however, an Intern's failure to show up on time, continuous request for time off, sick days, early departure, etc puts a burden on employees and interns who provide us with service without short comings. Interns providing us with service without scheduling conflicts are extremely appreciated. Our livestock depends on us for their care; availability and attendance is something that is paramount in this job. Requests for time off, vacations etc. must be placed at least a month in advance and must be approved by Krystle Lee.

It is very important that you as an intern of Suncoast Stables and Riding Academy, LLC are courteous, polite, and respectful to all customers and fellow employees/interns.

Summer interns will have the fortune to learn all different types of grooming, training, new tacking and tail setting techniques.
